The program includes the beautiful Dvorak Piano Quintet, the Bach C Major Two Piano Concerto, as well as arrangements of works by Piazzolla.



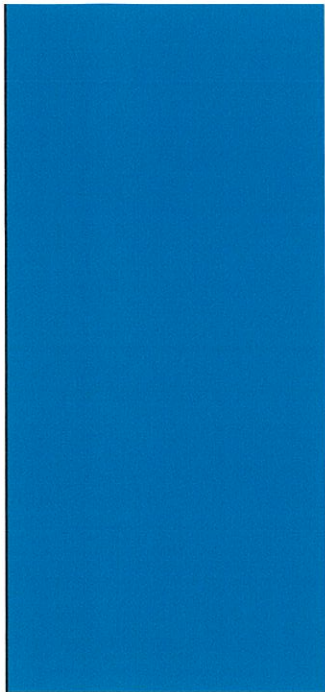

### Lest We Forget LCMS String Students Central Valley Academy of Music November 11 - 7pm

Conducted by Leslie Dala Concertmaster is Calvin Dyck This special collaboration will feature Metamorphosen, by Richard Strauss. This profound work was written in the final few months of World War II. Unusually, it is set for 23 solo strings. The work is a statement of mourning and reflection on Germany's destruction in the war and each part is unique.

The concert will also be the North American premier of a work written by Ian Hampton's father Colin Hampton, the renowned English cellist.



Entitled "La Corona" (the crown), it is a setting of the famous La Corona sonnets by John Donne, written for tenor and strings. This piece was the last piece written by Colin Hampton before his death in 1996 at the age of 85. The program also includes Bach's sublime and uplifting Brandenburg Concerto No. 3.
