

Announcing the "Shostakovich Project"

Senior string students at LCMS will be collaborating with the members of the Pacific Rim String Quartet (the professional quartet-in-residence at LCMS) in a project devoted to Dmitri Shostakovich's String Quartet No. 8. One of the most significant works of the 20th Century, this searingly personal composition was written exactly 50 years ago in Dresden, a city devastated by bombing during the Second World War. LCMS students will be learning the piece both in a version for string orchestra and in small groups coached by the PRSQ. They will also be learning the historical significance of the work, gaining appreciation both for the particular composition and the way in which the arts can help society make sense of history and culture. The project will culminate in a student performance of the complete quartet. The PRSQ will also be performing the work on May 13 as part of the Cafe Classico series at LCMS.
